Aged Population Review

Background

- Previous indication of desire to review the aged population
- Intention to proactively stimulate discussion/idea's
 - Possible future agenda topic to brainstorm other possibilities
 - Target current static volumes
- Initiated with review of individual pots
- Particular interest in high volumes & age of MPRN

Process

- We opted to initially focus on the **Legitimately Unregistered** population
 - Largest population / largest amount of aged sites
- Sought to establish/ring-fence sites for potential closure
 - Removed MPRN's with a status of CA/CL
 - Categorised MPRN's by age
 - Identified all MPRN's with a Meter attached
 - Cross-referenced through supplementary data report (check for MSN)
 - Searched for other indicators suggesting Network/Shipper activity

Findings / Volumes

- The total population analysed 33,973 sites
- Of which 24,775 were aged 10years or older*
- Where 10+ years & no evidence of activity** 24,098 sites
- The entire population only indicated 3% activity

 Desk top / Site Visit checks to ascertain physical status?
- Workgroup to agree consensus for next course of action
- Based upon findings consider similar reviews of other S&U pots
