#### Decision on Fleetwood entry point in gas transmission

On 4 August we published our decision to remove £277.5 million from NGGT's price control allowances in respect of the Fleetwood NTS entry point, and to lower the entry capacity obligation from 650 GWh/day to 350 GWh/day. More information can be found at the following URL:

### Statutory consultation under Section 23 of the Gas Act 1986 – Fleetwood entry capacity obligation

On 29 August 2017, we published a statutory consultation on changes to National Grid Gas's gas transporter licence to reduce the amount of capacity obligated to be released at Fleetwood from December 2017.
