National Grid NTS Metering Charges from 1st April 2010

Please find attached schedules showing National Grid NTS's revised metering charges to apply from 1st April 2010. National Grid NTS has submitted revised metering charges for those services that it is obliged to offer under its Gas Transporter (GT) Licence coupled with those services that are currently offered for historical/legacy purposes (i.e where a Datalogger or Converter has been fitted at an NTS Site or there is a maintenance requirement for an NTS High Pressure Meter Installation).

This notification is provided 2 months in advance of the effective date consistent with the notice period required under Section B 1.8.2 (b) of the Uniform Network Code.

National Grid NTS's metering charges are regulated by a price control set by Ofgem. To achieve price control, Ofgem has set tariff caps for four key metering services: Credit Meters, Prepayments Meters, Domestic Meter Exchanges and Daily Meter (DM) Reading. National Grid's charges for these services must not exceed the tariff caps, which are adjusted each year by inflation (RPI), as set out in the attached schedules.

The annual rental charges for industrial and commercial meters are reduced by 1.0% in respect of inflation from 1st April 2010, which is calculated in accordance with Special Condition C12 of the Licence.

National Grid is also adjusting its transaction charges for meter works to achieve better cost reflectivity.

The revised charges effective from 1 April 2010 will be published on National Grid's Internet site www.nationalgrid.com/uk/gas (under the Charging and Metering Charges pages), by the end of January 2010. Transactional Charges

Any work downstream of the outlet of the meter is excluded unless specifically mentioned. In all cases, service pipe installation, alteration and disconnection and meter box provision is excluded and will be subject to additional charges in accordance with Condition 4B of the GT Licence and will be quoted on an individual basis.

Domestic-Size Meters

The following charges relate to domestic-size meter installations, where the meter capacity is less than 11 standard cubic metres per hour (scmh).

Daily Meter Reading services

The Annual charge for Daily Meter (DM) reading has been set to the tariff cap of £440.87. This charge is calculated on a daily basis, at 120.7863 pence per day.
