**108.3 Matters for the UNCC's Attention**

- a) Draft Allocation of Unidentified Gas Statement 2014/15 – consideration of consultation responses

CWh advised that this was intended to be a Q&A session on the 1<sup>st</sup> Draft AUGS and no formal presentation was being made. He advised that Xoserve were going to provide updated data sets, which may answer a number of queries.

CWH explained a number of issues that had been identified, such as the possibility of double counting in Subdeduct configurations, meters in wrong LDZs, and consumption gaps and overlaps. He asked if participants present had any further questions on the 1<sup>st</sup> Draft AUGS they would like to raise at this time.

GE wanted to understand the impacts on the next statement. CWh felt a number of the issues raised in the responses were down to raw data issues, which sit across all industry processes and not just unallocated gas. Some of the data issues they would be able to predict and calculate the impacts quickly, whereas others needed further analysis. However, the changes would be expected to lead to a more accurate statement.

MB asked when the next version of the statement was due. CWh confirmed that it was on target for publication on 31 July.
