



## **EUC09 Sites not in Class 1**

PAC Update March 2020

# Recap

- UIG Task Force identified sites with AQs over the Class 1 threshold that are still in Class 3 or 4 (Issue 3.2.1)
- Obligations set out in UNC G1.6.15
- These sites should be re-confirmed as Class 1 by the Shipper after 3 consecutive AQ calculations above the threshold in a six-month period, or after 18 months if every calculated AQ is above the threshold
- These sites could be contributing to daily UIG if their usage pattern is very different to the EUC09B NDM profile
- Raised at UNC UIG Workgroup in January 2019 – recommended engagement by Xoserve and monitoring at PAC – last update provided at January 2020 PAC

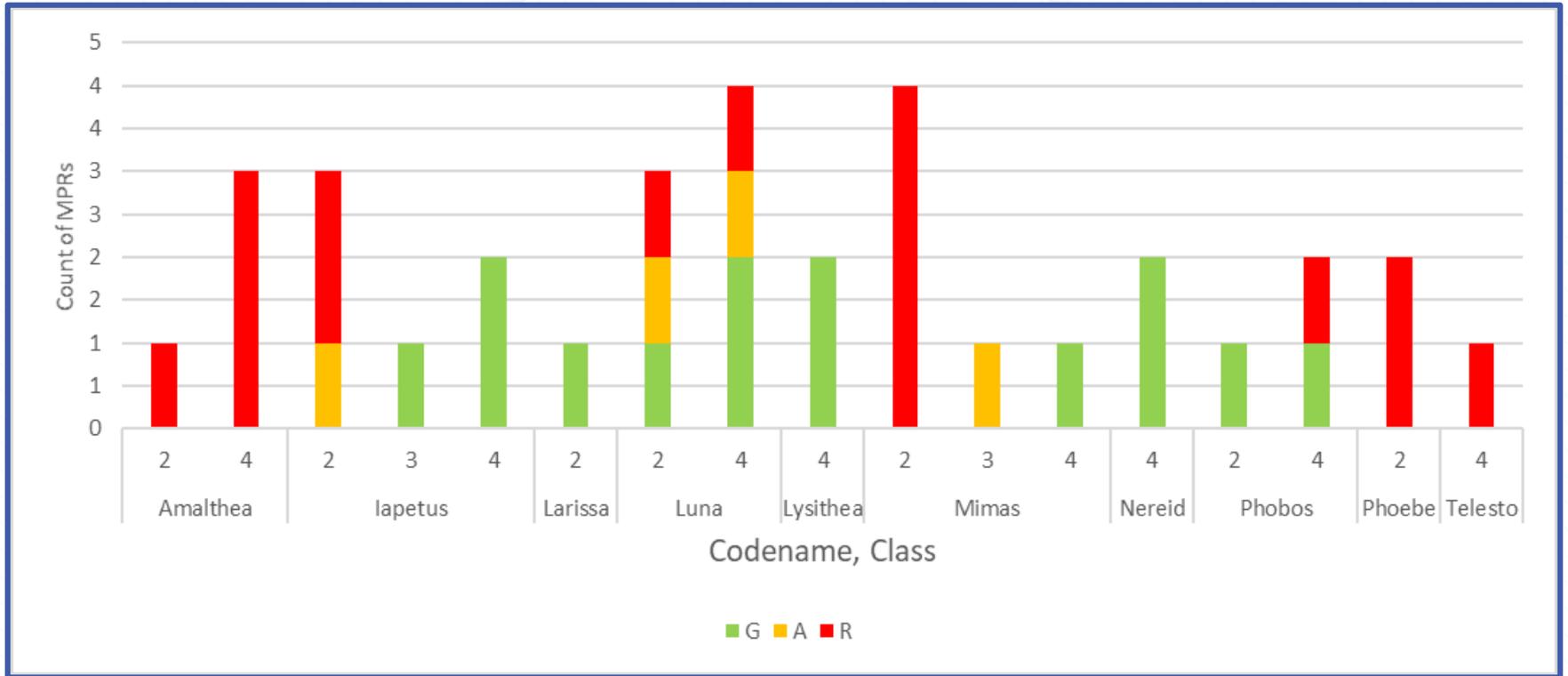
# Overview of Statistics – Changes since September

- As not yet included in the PARR, these stats have used the anonymised “Moon” codes
- Stats include Class 2, 3 and 4 sites **as at 1 March** – should be converted to Class 1 once qualifying criteria are met
- 6 Class 4 sites, total AQ 0.4 tWh (**increase of 3 sites**)
- 10 Class 2 sites, total AQ 2.6 tWh (reduced count, **increased AQ**)
- Plus 4 sites which are over threshold and close to qualifying criteria (total 0.3 tWh), 14 sites over threshold, not close to qualifying (total 1.3 tWh)

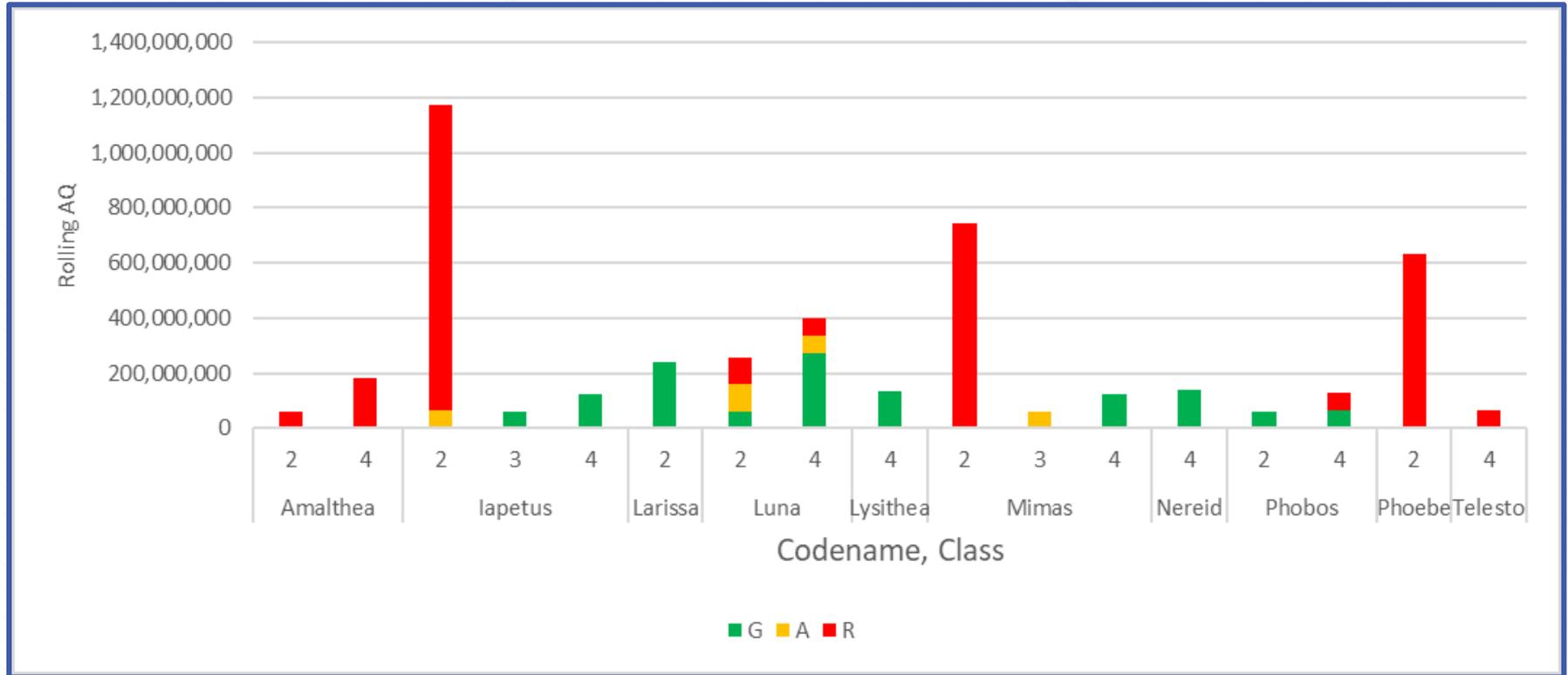

# Observations

- Now seven Shippers with Red sites this month (up from six in January)
- 11 of the Red sites had a meter reading loaded in March – good news for reconciliation and AQ accuracy – only one has not had an AQ calc in the last three months
- Of the 16 sites this month, 9 were present in the last update, 7 are new
