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1 Summary

Is this a Self-Governance Modification?

The Modification Panel determined that this is a self-governance modification because it is unlikely to have material effect on gas consumers; competition, the operation of pipe-line systems, safety or security of supply, the uniform network code governance procedures or the network code modification procedures.

Is this a Fast Track Self-Governance Modification?

The Modification Panel determined that this modification should be a Fast Track Self-Governance modification, and that the modification meets both the self-governance criteria and the fast track criteria as it seeks to reinstate a measurement within legal text previously used but amended accidentally through a previous UNC modification.

Why Change?

This change is required to amend TPD Section G 2.5.8(b). The change plans to reinstate the measure of Calendar Days into this section of the UNC. This change is required as UNC modification 0463S accidentally amended this to Supply Point Business Days which must now be corrected.

Solution

The change is required to amend the reference in TPD Section G 2.5.8(b) from Supply Point System Business Days to Calendar Days.

Relevant Objectives

The modification will have a positive effect on relevant objective (f); promotion of efficiency in the implementation and administration of the code.

Implementation

The modification could be implemented 16 business days after a vote in favour of implementation by the Modification Panel. No implementation costs are expected.

2 Why Change?

The change is required to amend TPD Section G 2.5.8(b). The change plans to reinstate the measure of calendar days into this section of the legal text to reverse an error created during the implementation of Modification 0463S.

3 Solution

This modification seeks to amend TPD Section G 2.5.8(b) by removing Supply Point Systems Business Day from the legal text and replacing it with Calendar Days as previously used in Modification 0403.

6 Legal Text

Text

Amend paragraph 2.5.8(b) to read as:

"2.5.8 The Proposed Supply Point Registration Date shall be:

- (a) not more than 30 Supply Point Systems Business Days after the Supply Point Confirmation is submitted; and
- (b) not less than 20 ~~calendar Supply Point Systems Business D~~days commencing on the Day after the Supply Point Confirmation is submitted unless:

 - (iii)
- (c)"

7 Panel Discussions

The Panel Chair summarised that Modification 0496 seeks to amend TPD Section G 2.5.8(b) by removing Supply Point Systems Business Day from the legal text and replacing it with Calendar Days as previously used in Modification 0403.

Members considered the relevant objective (f) promotion of efficiency in the implementation and administration of the Code and agreed that implementation of this change would have positive impact on this relevant objective.

Members voted unanimously to recommend implementation of Modification 0496.
