AL apologised for the lateness of the amended modification, explaining she had been awaiting the publication of the CMA Report before considering amending the modification to ensure it aligned to any objectives set out in the report. She explained she had now also added the PAC rules into the modification so that the PAC would assess meter read submissions over a period of time and take steps if required. AL said she was going to discuss this further with Ofgem. SH offered JD's comments on this matter and that they would support a modification that puts in place a process in the UNC rather than drive a requirement through licence changes – the industry would be seen to be putting in place measures on a pro active basis. SMu asked if it might be necessary to raise another

modification to address the risks from the CMA direct, and not linked to PAC? AL said that it would need to be a totally separate modification and would stand alone, which might mean it could go through the process quicker. SMu wanted to see measures adopted through a modification rather than requiring licence changes.
