Thank you for giving EDF Energy the opportunity to respond to Network Code Modification Proposal 0017 "Amendments to the provisions governing 'failure' to obtain readings".

EDF Energy supports the implementation of this proposal.

It is appropriate that Shippers are given 4 months to resolve any data anomalies that the transporter has identified, when taking the 'must read'. This should allow sufficient time scales for resolution to be reached.

Shippers need this time to undertake an investigation with the relevant party. Therefore there is no benefit in continuing with the 'must read' request until resolution has been reached, or the time elapsed. With the introduction of RGMA, Meter Asset Managers may need to be made aware of data anomalies so they can amend their data accordingly. This process will help to ensure Suppliers are billing their end consumers, using accurate data.
