**Response to UNC Modification Proposal 069 Amendment of
Network Entry Provisions at the European Interconnector sub-
terminal at Bacton**

Dear Tim

E.ON UK supports this proposal. We agree with the Proposer that this proposal should enhance security of supply, through allowing greater volumes of gas to be imported through the European Interconnector.

We would like to take this opportunity to commend the pragmatic approach taken by National Grid and the Environment Agency in contributing to industry discussions to resolve Users' initial concerns that the proposal would disadvantage some Users with respect to sulphur limits in gas used for generation.

The outcome of such discussions has consequently led to a greater understanding of the issues surrounding the proposal and the resulting early assurances given by the Environment Agency with respect to sulphur limits, thereby enabling us to fully support the proposal.
