Modification Proposal 0071 and 0071a – User Compensation for NEC Storage Curtailment

Total Gas & Power Limited (TGP) do not support implementation of either Urgent Modification Proposal, however should one be implemented our preference would be for implementation of 71a.:

- We are disappointed that further urgent modifications continue to be raised in this
 area so late into the winter. We consider this provides the industry with insufficient
 time to fully evaluate the implications of either modification proposal and risks
 further unintended consequences and the need for further corrective urgent
 modifications.
- TGP supported the approach within mod proposal 52, i.e. to leave shippers
 financially 'neutral' via an SWCQ adjustment. We continue to believe the form and
 structure of compensation provided for under mod 52 remains broadly appropriate
 for this winter and would prefer refinements to be developed in the context of a
 post-winter review.
