Thank you for the opportunity to respond on Mod 0075. RWE npower would like to offer our support in respect of this proposal.

RWE Npower consider that the NExA table is pivotal in determining the charges that CSEP Users have to pay to both iGTs and Large Transporters. We are concerned that inaccuracies in the AQ Values in the NExA further exposes Users to the misallocation of energy volumes through the RbD smearing method.

For these reasons RWE Npower suggest that it may be appropriate to reference or include the NExA table in the Uniform Network Code due to the impacts it has on Users of the Code.
