## Response to UNC Modification Proposal 080 Acceptance of AMR reads at supply points with correctors

E.ON UK supports the implementation of Modification Proposal 080. We agree with the Proposer that this proposal will better facilitate relevant objective A11.1(a) the efficient and economic operation of the pipe-line system and (d) (i) and (ii) the securing of effective competition between relevant shippers and between relevant suppliers, through allowing a greater number of meter readings to be accepted on the systems, improving the correct estimation and deeming processes and thereby, the planning and operation of the networks.

We also agree that implementation of the proposal will achieve the following listed advantages:

- reduces the installation costs of AMR equipment
- a greater number of meter readings will be available to Users to issue to the transporter.
- a higher proportion of AMR readings will reduce exposure to the risk associated with manual readings .
