Representation for Modification Proposal 0154: “Enduring Provisions for LDZ System Entry Points”.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment upon this modification proposal, the implementation of which WWU supports.

In addition to providing suitable enduring arrangements for storage facilities to enter gas into an LDZ, implementation of this proposal will allow new, potentially small, sources of gas embedded within an LDZ, such as land fill and mines gas, to be made available to the market. The utilisation of these sources of gas may deliver an environmental benefit to the UK and, subject to any DTI review, could be subject to the ROCs regime. This market is significantly more developed in Europe.

The inclusion of UNC provisions for LDZ System Entry Points complements the DN licence condition SSC D12.
