British Gas fully supports the implementation of this modification proposal.

Following changes to the Capacity / Commodity charging arrangements, which will come into effect on 1st of October 2008, Failure to Interrupt (FTI) charges and Interruptible Firm Allowance (IFA) charges need to be revised in order to ensure that they remain reflective and appropriate.

Implementation of this proposal will ensure that an appropriate charging methodology is in place after the 1st October changes, which will ensure that there is no inappropriate discrimination between different market sectors and that charges and discounts to interruptible sites remain cost reflective.

We also agree that the incorrect reference to Section 10.5.3 within UNC Transition Document Part IIC 10.4.2 should be amended to refer to Section 10.4.3.
