We agree that bringing the Network Entry Agreement of the SAGE sub terminal at St Fergus into line with the GSMR lower and upper Wobbe limits is appropriate and has the potential to increase the volume of UKCS gas that could be brought to market, thus enhancing the security of domestic customer supply and potentially enhancing competition.
