Regarding UNC Modification Proposal 0259, 'Removal Of Obligations To Install UK Link User Equipment and UK Link User Software for UK Link Users who utilise the services of an UK Link User Agent'

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above proposals which seek to remove the obligation for Transporters to provide equipment and network access for all Shippers. Corona Energy (CE) supports modification 259 as the current process appears to unnecessarily create costs for users.

CE understands that the XP1 Token Process provides an alternative to the provision of UK Link User Equipment in all circumstances and CE therefore agrees with the proposer that this modification will remove the need for Transporters to unnecessarily install UK Link equipment, software and IX network access at shipper's premises.
