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RE: Modification Proposal 0269 - Provision of Exit Information at all NTS Exit Points for the transitional exit period

E.ON UK **supports** implementation of Modification Proposal 0269 on the basis that it would help meet wider European market transparency requirements. We do not believe that this data is commercially sensitive when published on an *ex-post* monthly basis and therefore do not object to it being published in the format prescribed in the proposal.

However, we struggle to see what genuine use the information will be to market participants during the so-called 'transitional period' before Exit Reform is introduced. To this end, we are unable to explain how the proposal better facilitates the relevant objectives and we are unconvinced by the reasons sets out by the proposer. As far as we can see, the only supporting rationale is that implementation would enable National Grid NTS to more fully meet obligations under EC Regulation 1775/2005.
