EXPERT DETERMINATION

- 1. Automatic Expert Determination for all MERs greater than 50GWh
 - Potential to create duplication of work
 - Cost
 - Removes potential for manipulation
- 2. Independent Calculation of MER by Expert
 - Potential to reduce costs for Transporters
 - Removes potential for manipulation
 - Provides assurance of independent, unbiased MER
 - Provides Transparency to industry





ISSUES TO BE RESOLVED

- 1. Selection of Experts
 - Experts to be selected by Offtake Committee taking consideration of any User suggestions
 - List to be reviewed annually to ensure that it remains applicable
 - Expert for MER to be appointed by Offtake Committee taking consideration of any User suggestions
- 2. Terms of Reference
 - Expert to be employed to develop a MER using the most appropriate methodologies to ensure that as accurate as possible MER is produced
 - Expert to report directly to Offtake Committee and any sub-committee formed
 - Expert to provide monthly reports to Offtake Committee and any sub-committee formed on proposed methodologies, issues identified and potential solutions
 - Expert to listen to and respond to any issues raised by the appropriate group
 - Expert to ensure that the procedures laid down in Notification Process are followed





GOVERNANCE

1. Ancillary Document to OAD

- Under Governance of Offtake Committee
- Users would require ability to raise changes to ancillary document and vote on these changes
- Creates complexity
- Introduces Users into the OAD
- 2. Ancillary Document to TPD
 - Referenced in TPD Section J (7.3?)
 - Under Governance of UNC Committee
 - Users currently have rights to raise changes and vote on these changes
 - Maintains the OAD as a Transporter to Transporter Document
