- 4. Workgroup went through the Workgroup Report Drafting document, a change marked version is published on the website as version 5.0. Through discussion Workgroup participants suggested amendments and comments which were noted in the document to the following topics:

NTS Optional Charge

- Updating costs for RPI;
- Use of a distance cap;
- Enduring arrangements;
- Methodology for the NTS Optional Charge.
- 5. Following the mornings UNC Panel meeting, which was held to consider new alternative Modification 0621L, Julie Cox provided a brief description of the difference in this Modification against 0621 Modification which is to include historical contracts in the calculation of the FCC and the RPM.
- 6. The Workgroup agreed that with the addition of 0621K and 0621L the proposers of these and all alternative Modifications need to assist in the Workgroup Report Drafting to advise of any wording amendments or additions on the topics that have been covered so far.
- 7. Danishtah Parker and Joanne Parker provided an update on Action 120418: 0416 GDN Workgroup participants to update workgroup for Modification 0621 on how NTS pricing changes will change DN Charges and articulate the potential impact on consumers.
