

Why change? - Use case background

- JMDG developed use case for Supplier access to gas and electricity data via API
- Purpose to support Suppliers in:
 - Provide quotation services to customer
 - Improve the quality of the switch request into UK Link
 - Improved creation of customer account on Supplier records
- JMDG recommended service to MIS Programme Board
- MIS Programme Board agreed and approved
- MIS Programme Board (gas) sponsoring UNC modification to give effect to use case delivery
- Modification required to permit release of data to Suppliers

Options

- Prepared along same lines as Modification 0640S: Provision of access to Domestic Consumer data for Suppliers
- Commercial arrangements same as developed under Modification 0640S
- Extension of data items and to non-domestic data
- Mod limits permission to Suppliers, not PCW or TPI

Solution

Amend UNC text to permit release of data to Suppliers

Recommended Steps

- The Proposer recommends that this modification should be:
 - Subject to self-governance
 - Workgroup assessment to develop the modification for 2 months
