ACER's report on TSOs' revenues

Background

- Art. 34 TAR NC: ACER is obliged to produce the report on 'methodologies and parameters used to determine the allowed/target revenue of TSOs'
- ACER hired a consultant (ECA) to produce the report. An event was organised on 20 Sept. to present the provisional report (report will be published late Oct.)

Report content and provisional conclusions

- Description of EU Member State methodologies
 - Covering: overall regulatory framework; determining and setting expenditures; regulatory asset base; WACC; other regulatory mechanisms
- Evaluation of EU methodological practises (this goes beyond what we wanted)
 - Covering topics listed above evaluation of the relative effectiveness of methodologies
 - Categorisation of objectives: economic efficiency, risk allocation, other regulatory and consumer issues

Report content and provisional conclusions (cont...)

- Report explores if there can be a level of consistency and standardisation between NRAs
- ECA see report as starting point for more transparency
- Acknowledge that harmonisation wouldn't be appropriate for many regulatory components, including the overall regulatory framework, due to national conditions
- Harmonised glossary / definitions not included too much variation throughout EU

Stakeholders and EC

- Stakeholders generally supportive
 - 'benchmarking' was encourage by IFIEC
- EC welcomed the report:
 - will be used to feed into future EC studies on TSO revenue
- Number of NRAs sceptical: "regulating the regulator" National Grid

FUNC Issue on Data Exchange Solutions at Virtual Trading Points (VTPs) and storage

- ENTSOG's current thinking is that any INT Code amendment should only cover trade nominations, not trade notifications or storage sites
- Further discussion scheduled in October with ACER and other stakeholders

- ENTSOG shall be developing a coordinated response to ACER
