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## **Action 0901: National Grid Response**

- Action 0901 from October Transmission Workgroup:
  - "National Grid NTS (PH) to provide a view on the proposed Request proposal scope, and how best to progress this matter going forwards"
- At the October Workgroup, National Grid did not propose to progress a DSR review via a UNC Request
- Rather, National Grid announced its intention to undertake an 'information gathering' exercise in relation to Gas DSR in Q4 2018 in order to inform the most appropriate questions to ask in its formal annual DSR consultation which will be launched in Q1 2019
- Customers and stakeholders were invited to contact National Grid if they wished to express views on this topic
- The Workgroup requested clarification from National Grid on what the scope of such a discussion would be

## **Action 0901: National Grid Response**

- National Grid considers that relevant questions for such a discussion could include:
- Do you consider there to be any operational or contractual barriers to the development of an effective gas DSR mechanism?
- Which aspects of the electricity market do you see as having an impact on whether gas DSR can be offered? Has anything changed since the DSR mechanism was introduced which affects its implementation?
- What changes do you expect to see in the electricity market within the next five years that may be relevant for the gas DSR mechanism?
- What are your views about the current 'Site-Shipper-National Grid' contractual chain as the basis for the gas DSR mechanism?
- Do you have any other views about the value of the gas DSR mechanism as a means of response to events such as those which occurred on 1st March 2018?
