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Licence Change Proposal for new points

National Grid made a proposal to Ofgem to update our Licence to change the process for adding new points

The purpose is to make the process of adding new points which have no associated capacity obligations **simpler and quicker**

Licence Change Proposal - update

Licence Change is in 2 parts...

PART A –New points required to be added to licence x 3.

- Ofgem consultation closed 22/11
- Ofgem decision expected December 2018
- Implementation + 56 days from decision

PART B – Proposal focused on facilitating Project CLoCC delivery to make reference to adding New Points to Zero Baseline table outside of Licence.

- Developed proposal with Ofgem
- Draft legal text produced
- Consultations required

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Change Summary

In summary the change proposed is..

- To have a table outside of the licence to record new points with zero baseline capacity.
- National Grid to maintain the table, giving opportunity for Ofgem to veto.
- Existing Long Term Summary Report to be used to publish the table.
