2. Change Proposals

2.1. XRN4665 Creation of new End User Categories

Simon Harris (SH) explained that XRN4665 is looking to add new EUC profiles for bands 01B & 02B, EUC bands 03 to 09 are not affected by this change, and that Xoserve are seeking approval today for the change proposal to move forward to the Design stage.

It was highlighted that there were a number of considerations raised with DSG on 07 January, these were:

EUC Naming convention

The EUC Naming convention, which is slightly different to what was on the Change Proposal, was explained and the logic that is being applied.

The Load Factors will be as follows:

- EUC Band 1 Domestic non-prepayment
- EUC Band 2 Industrial non-prepayment

EUC band 1 follows a Domestic profile and EUC Band 2 follows an Industrial profile.

CSEP Creation/Amendments

SH advised that some concerns were raised regarding the proposed rule for CSEP creation/amendments and these have now been resolved with the responder. SH highlighted that the proposal is inline with the 'ASIS' process for CSEPs. KB confirmed that her concerns had been addressed.

Twin stream

Twin Stream Supply Meter Points, where multiple Meter Devices are present, additional rules are required to determine the EUC Meter Type.

Telemetered

Telemetered Supply Points on UK Link are set up with dummy devices and as a result an additional rule will be needed to determine the EUC Meter Type.

No additional concerns were raised, therefore, SH sought approval to move forward with the design.

When asked, ESm confirmed that Xoserve now have a checklist in place to capture specific site and customer group considerations going forward for future change proposals.

This was originally thought to be a Shipper only vote, however, due to the CSEP impacts it was agreed that IGTs should be included.

Shippers and IGTs unanimously approved XRN4665 to move forward to Design.
