Why change?

 The references in the UNC to Data Protection Act 1998 need to be amended to Data Protection Act 2018 to reflect the introduction of EU General Data Protection Regulations 2018

Options

Do nothing.

 Leaving the references unchanged would do not affect the fact the law has changed and Parties need to comply with UK law but would not be helpful.

Remove all reference to Data Protection Act

• This is an option and would remove what are, arguably, un-necessary references to the Data Protection Act.

• This could not be done as Fast Track Self-Governance

 Raise a Fast Track Self-Governance modification to change the references

Solution

- The following references to the Data Protection Act 1998 should be replaced with Data Protection Act 2018:
 - TPD G 2.1.13,
 - TPD V 5.3.4,
 - IGTAD F 5.1.3.

Recommended Steps

•The Proposer recommends that this modification should be:

- Subject to Fast Track self-governance because
 - it meets the self-governance criteria; and
 - it is a housekeeping modification required to update the reference to the Data Protection Act in three places in Code.
