DPP and data provision update



PAFA DDP development

- PAFA have been working closely with the DDP BETA testing team on the implementation of the PAFA insights module;
 - First DDP drop for PAFA will include:
 - Transfer read performance
 - Estimated reads
 - No reads for 1-4+ years
- Very beneficial being involved in the early stages of development
 - Comments and suggestions are being listen to and concerns addressed very quickly
- One development rollover into next phase but phase 1 approved for release by PAFA
- Due to the nature of sprint implementation currently not clear when all current
 PARR data will be available on the DDP

PAFA DDP Development

- Use of the DDP platform will not give the PAFA access to more data than they have currently
- If approved Modification 0707, will put the PAFA on the DPM
 - DSC will still need to approve data item access
 - Question whether this is applicable to the provision of data currently available in the PARR suite?
- Nature of DDP development and the sprint process means that no final 'PARR' DDP delivery date is available at present

PARR report updates

- Outputs of PARR workshop circulated to Panel members on 03/12/19
 - No comments received so proceeding with implementation of data items requested
- Existing PARR reports that need to be significantly amended following the workshop will need to go through the UNCC for approval
 - Majority of changes are additional information for the 'B' reports so should not require approval?
- Plan is for as much of the additional data requirements to be factored into the future DDP drops, although a timeframe/schedule is not currently available to limit PAC costs

PARR report process

- 3 ways in which a PARR report can be requested/amended:
 - 1. Changes proposed to an existing PARR report
 - 2. PAC identify the need for a new PARR report
 - 3. implementation of UNC modification report requires creation of a PARR report



- Until DDP if fully rolled out or relevant data items are available all new/amended PARR reports will be delivered via current channels
- PAFA are considering appropriate monitoring, prioritisation and cost views?
