2. For Vote

2.1. June 2020 Reduced Scope Market Trials (agenda item 7.2 from 11 February 2020 Change Management Meeting

James Rigby (JR) explained that due to a clash with the Market Trials for CP/XRN4850 Notification of Customer Contact Details to Transporters with the CSS Market Trials there was a lack of engagement from a Shipper perspective. A Change Pack had been issued with a 5-day consultation for a reduction in scope. JR confirmed that 3 responses had been received with 2 approvals and 1 rejection. Today Xoserve wanted to seek a steer from the Committee on the need to continue to develop market trials and for Xoserve to flag it is reliant on Shippers taking part.

Surfaraz Tambe (ST) explained the importance Shipper involvement. It was noted there was no forth coming views that Shippers would be taking part.

JR enquired from the Shippers present about the interest to participate. Mark Jones (MJ) was not able to provide Xoserve with any confirmed interest as tis had not been discussed at their constituency meeting.

JR confirmed that Xoserve are willing to proceed with the trials for those that want to be involved and asked if the trial without Shippers would be meaningful and be of benefit, bearing in mind the costs involved.

Guv Dosanjh (GD) asked for clarification on the value of the trials without Shipper engagement, JR explained the limitation of the trials without Shippers but that Xoserve would continue if Transporters believed this would be is useful.

ES explained the what UAT processes could take place and the risks associated with the lack of Shipper involvement. ES was keen to understand what Xoserve could do for the Transporters to provide assurance that the process will work as expected.

Helen Chandler (HCh) noted that as this was a new process not just for Transporters but also Shippers and that she would like to see a demonstration that the process works before it is released into the live environment. HCh was concerned about not undertaking trials and the outcomes if Shipper interactions do not work as expected.

Mark Jones (MJ) suggested further discussions are held with the constituencies about the participation with Market Trials.

ES stressed the importance of having a decision by 11 March to allow preparations to start testing. ES believed it would be worthwhile outlining and communicating the risks of not having a full Market trail to ensure these are fully understood.

HCh asked about the reduction in funding with a reduced market trial. ES with no market trial there would be a £77k saving but there would still be some costs associated with uploading files.

Rebecca Cailes (RC) asked about the possibility of testing systems without Shippers. ES explained the data flows and due to the direct customer involvement, there was a view market trials were needed.

HCh believed the market trails still needed to go ahead and if there is a lack of Shipper participation a communication should be issued to explain why certain aspects could not be tested.

ES agreed to communicate that the market trial will go ahead and Xoserve will continue to secure shipper participation.

Representatives were asked to vote continue with Market Trials. This was unanimously by all parties present:
