St Fergus Consultation on the range of future charging and commercial solutions that should be considered ahead of any proposed investment options

- National Grid has launched a consultation related to works associated to emissions legislation compliance and asset health at the NSMP Gas Transmission Sub Terminal at St Fergus, specifically to seek views on the appropriate balance of how these works should be paid for, such as by the use of targeted charging. The consultation will close on 13 September 2021.
- Should targeting be taken forward then there will be UNC Modification proposals discussed and proposed in due course.
- We are asking for stakeholder views on how to recover essential works at St Fergus via Transportation charges and are also asking for stakeholder input into the potential range of commercial remedies that may be available as an alternative to investment that we haven't yet considered.
