# Why change?

#### Reasons for framework and Net Zero Use case remain:

- Currently there is no concept of derogation within the UNC.
- Net Zero has a fixed timeline of 2050
- Net Zero innovation projects need the ability to trial solutions.

# Original 0760 had Merit, but due to needed amendments including:

- Approvals & Appeals
- HSE derogations approval timelines

## Options

Treat this as if it is a new mod without reference to 0760
Longer timescales for workgroup etc,
require full review of everything again
Increase time it till take Ofgem to consider
Risk to H projects (e.g. village trials)

Treat this as if it is a new mod without reference to 0760
 WG to focus only on Ofgem rejection letter and red-lined text
 FMR and consultation to also focus on this area
 Allowing for quicker progress via workgroup
 Facilitating faster decision from Ofgem

### Solution – Concept of Derogation

- Introduce the concept of derogation Framework
- Introduce Use Case for Net Zero innovation projects.
- Allow derogations from UNC and UNC related documents with the exception on
  - Modification rules
  - oActive SCRs
  - OAnything that impacts a supplier or end consumers ability to switch
- •Introduce an Innovation Derogation Guidance Document.
  - owhich clearly lays out the application & approval process including evidence required and the considerations by UNC Panel members

## Solution – Changes from UNC0760

Red Lined changes are in relation to:

 Panel recommendation, all derogations will be Authority Direction.

oThis will also impact, how a derogation is revoked 'Early Cessation Report'

# •All HSE & safety related derogations must be approved prior to panel recommendation

•All other (code) derogations must have been requested prior to panel recommendation

#### **Recommended Steps**

The Proposer recommends that this modification should be:

- Subject to Authority Direction
- 0760 was agreed by Panel to be material
- Focus on changes from 0760, not whole mod
- Whilst a new mod, for Panel to agree to the 'red line' approach (as if it was a send back)
- The modification be subject to workgroup for a further period of 1 month.
- Already been discussed in detail at Governance 14/2/22
- Version 2.0 to be published next week, before next Governance WG
