Impact

- For Missing Messages, the Switching Operator has indicated that they cannot generate the Secured Active Message
- UNC envisages that we will get formal Secured Active Synch messages, and references 'Notifications' as a term from the REC
 - (d) Definitive Registration Notification means:
 - in relation to a Registration Request, a Notification sent to the CDSP that the Registration Request is Secured Active as described in paragraphs 5.2.3(f)(i) and 5.2.3(f)(ii);

Notification	means a type of Market Message, as described
	in the Switching Data Management Schedule.

- The Code does state that we are **not required** to accept messages other than those specified in the REC (c) the CDSP shall not be required to act on any communication from the CSS
 - the CDSP shall not be required to act on any communication from the CSS Provider which is not in accordance with the REC or in compliance with any CSS Process:
 - Suggestion to allow CDSP the discretion to do so?
 - Suggest that this is '[validated/approved]' by [UNCC] so that this is not precedent
