  - exposure to extreme cash out prices if in balance a Shipper would not be affected, so risk would be limited;
  - *if a Shipper fails, the Supplier faces cash out prices this risk could be mitigated by effectively allowing a Supplier to become a party to Code in these circumstances;*
  - risks emerge from delays when appointing a Supplier of Last Resort accelerating the process would help;
  - to offset risks by increasing credit requirements would increase other risks too much and could be counter-productive.
