016Dis Termination of Dormant Shipper Licences

It would be beneficial to be able to voluntarily terminate dormant Shipper Licences. If it was possible to terminate a Licence where there were no longer any sites associated with it and use an active Shipper Licence to act on behalf of the dormant Shipper Licence, it could then take over the legacy responsibilities caused by any ongoing reconciliation.

IGT/DNO/Shipper Interaction with NExA Agreements. Currently there is no commercial incentive for the IGTs to provide required information, impacting revenue, billing, security of supply and RbD. Modification Proposals have been raised, however iGTs are opposed to some of the modifications, National Grid will be writing to the iGTs seeking changes to the NExA.

009Dis Sunset Provisions 12 July 2006 – Modification 0704.
