1.0 Introduction and Status Review

1.1 Minutes from June Workstream

1.1 Review of Live Modification Proposals and Topics Log

BF summarised changes to the Modification Register since the previous Distribution Workstream meeting.

2.0 Modification Proposals

2.1 Proposal 0197: "Increasing User Incentives for the Investigation and Detection of Theft through the Reasonable Endeavours Regime"

As the Proposer (MD) was not present this was carried forward to next month.

2.3. Proposal 0199: "Clarification around the application of the UNC Dispute Resolution Process"

The workstream report was completed, however Transporter representatives reiterated the view that there was sufficient clarity and they considered that the Modification was not needed.

2.4. Proposal 0218: "Amendment to the base period used to define Seasonal Normal weather"

SB gave a presentation which gave the background to the Proposal and explained it was an enabling Modification to allow the potential to be able to do something different in 2010 and consider the use of forecast data rather than just historical data. She stressed that it was to make the Code more flexible and it would not mandate the use of forecast data.

JM reported that there had been concern over the tight timetable to achieve 1/12/2008 implementation date.

SB advised that the date was not critical, but she was aware that xoserve would be holding discussions with the Transporters in early 2009 to set Seasonal Normal from October 2009 and they would need to be mindful of this Proposal.

ST noted that there was a disjoint between the Proposal which talked about using Met Office forecast data and the suggested legal text which did not. He was unclear how text could be drafted to fit in with the Code as the current methodology was prescriptively defined.

BD questioned where the current weather data was obtained from. FC confirmed that there were a number of data providers.

ST noted that the data currently used is actual historical data rather than forecast. SB pointed out that forecast data is currently used in the Code for day ahead allocation.

A discussion evolved around different forecaster's using different methodologies and the longer the forecast the greater the reliance on assumptions.

SB advised that the "Met Office decadal prediction model" had been developed in order to forecast ten years ahead in order to improve the UK planning baseline.

ST questioned how long the model had been used for and SB confirmed that it was a new model but it had been used to backcast 15 years where it had showed a 20% improvement over the forecast used, which was based on the current 17 year historical average.

RR noted that 1-in-20 Peak Day would not be affected if the new method of forecast was adopted and any change to the way 1-in-20 Peak Day is calculated would require a Licence change.

FC clarified that even though the assumption for Seasonal Normal will be based on warmer temperatures than historically used and therefore result in lower AQs, Peak Day is still the estimate of what is the coldest possible day.

SB confirmed that the Proposal related to the average and not the extreme.

SB agreed to consider amendments to the Proposal in the light of comments received.

Action 0701: SB to consider amendments to the Proposal.

The final Review Group 0157 Report was finalised at the Ofgem CSEP NExA Meeting on 14 July. This was accepted by the 17 July Panel Meeting.

3.2 025Dis, User Pays

An additional Governance Workstream meeting was held on 7 July to discuss Modification Proposal 0213, the next meeting would be the normal Governance Workstream to be held on 21 August. ST considered it would be

useful to send out a note informing the industry that 0213 was to be discussed.

3.4 030Dis, DN Shrinkage Changes

ST reported that DN's were moving ahead with changes to be Implemented by UNC 0203 which is due to commence on 1 October. It was also noted that a Shrinkage Forum meeting to discuss this on 11 July was cancelled due to low level of attendance.

3.5 031Dis, Maintenance of Best Practice Guidelines for gas and electricity network operator credit cover

ST felt establishing a cross-industry group would be helpful. Ofgem have agreed to consider whether they would wish to lead any further work in this area which was recognised as a cross-industry issue.

ST reported that iGT Proposal 021 had been raised which would reflect Credit Arrangements in the iGT UNC.
