**Amendment to Invitation to participate in the July 2012
NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity Annual Application Window**

Please be advised that there was an omission from the Invitation to participate in the July 2012 NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity Annual Application Window letter dated 01st June 2012.

It has been brought to our attention that the following location was not included in the original letter.

Hill Top Farm (Hole House Farm)

Please be advised that this location will be included in the forthcoming NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity Annual Application Window. We apologise for any inconvenience this omission may have caused.

For information, the remaining available Annual NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity for each relevant Gas Year in respect of each NTS Exit Point is shown in **Table One** below.

In accordance with the UNC TPD Section B3.4.2(c), the quantity of unsold Annual NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity made available for a full year shall be the amount of Remaining Available NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity that is available for all Gas Days within that Gas Year.
