Notification of Amendment to the Invitation to participate in the Enduring Annual Application for NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity

Following the decision from the Authority to approve recent modifications made to the National Grid Gas Transportation Licence (the Licence) pursuant to section 23 of the Gas Act 1986, this letter provides the appropriate updates to the data tables recently released to NTS Users in the "Invitation to participate in the Enduring Annual Application for NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity" on 3rd June 2009.

The Licence required National Grid Gas to release the invitation letter as noted above no later than 28 days prior to the first day of the Annual Application window for NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity (July 1st 2009). Therefore, due to the decision to approve the recent licence modification occurring after the 28 day notice period, this update has been issued and shall supersede the data table as sent in the original invitation letter.

Please note that the licence modifications were necessary to include new NTS exit points and correct the descriptions used for some existing points. Furthermore if the Authority approves the document titled "Licence modification consultation on baselines at Gas Distribution Network Operator exit points" (Ofgem document ref: 61/09) and the associated Section 23 Notice then National Grid Gas will reissue a further amendment to the "Available NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity" in table one.
