Release of NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity

 UNC TPD B 3.5 – NG NTS proposed to retain the times for all the mandatory allocations, but change the latest time for allocations to be made from D 02:00 to D 01:00

 A preference has been expressed from one party for this time to be retained at D 02:00 to allow shippers the opportunity of an additional exit capacity allocation should it be required by NG NTS

NG NTS View

- To accommodate a discretionary capacity allocation up to D 02:00 further analysis would be required:
 - Other D 02:00 capacity time references are being altered to 01:00 to reflect the forward movement of capacity processes at the start of the Day. If the option to release Exit (Flat) Capacity is retained up until 02:00 the timings in relation to other capacity processes will need to be reviewed as there is a direct link between these processes
 - When the clock change for daylight saving occurs, the Gemini outage occurs an hour early (02:00 in the new Gas Day time). Therefore capacity could not be released at 02:00 and NG NTS would not be able to meet their obligation within UNC


NG NTS View (2)

- NG NTS view is that maintaining a discretionary allocation up to D 02:00 may be of limited benefit. WDDSEC Bids Gas Year 2012-2013:
 - There were a total of 242 WDDSEC bids for the whole Gas Year (Equivalent to < 1 per Day)</p>
 - Approximately 7% were for allocations run in addition to the mandatory allocations
 - There were no additional allocations run between D 01:00 01:59 hours
- Also the latest time to submit Exit (Flat) Capacity bids is D 00:00 (Annex B1 3.2). Consequently there would be no further opportunity for shippers to submit new bids for a discretionary D 02:00 allocation
