## Extracted business rules from MOD 394

- 1. Remove references to "Suggested text".
- 2. Any legal text provided to the JO would be considered the actual legal text to be inserted into the code.
- 3. Only Mods which have the legal text can proceed to consultation phase.
- 4. The legal text version included in the DMR for the consultation phase must be the same version of legal text inserted in the code if the MOD is implemented.
- 5. An additional UNC Panel majority vote required (prior to the UNC Panel vote to determine if a MOD proceeds to consultation) to determine whether the legal text accurately reflects the intent of the MOD.
- 6. Where the Panel does not determine that the legal text accurately reflects the intent of the MOD the Proposal should be referred back to the Workgroup.
- 7. Remove any determination in relation to whether legal text is prepared or not as it would always be prepared prior to the consultation phase.
- 8. The Transporters will continue to prepare the legal text although the Proposer may prepare the legal text if they wish.
- 9. The workgroup must determine that the legal text accurately reflects the MOD Proposal.
- 10. Where any change is proposed to the legal text after the MOD has proceeded to the consultation phase then the matter must be brought to the attention of the UNC Panel.
- 11. The Panel to make a determination based on a majority vote as to whether the change to the legal text is immaterial.
- 12. Where the Panel votes that the change is immaterial the MOD would continue in the Modification Process.
- 13. Where the Panel determines that the change is not immaterial the Panel would refer the MOD to a Workgroup or for further consultation.
