We would still offer qualified support for the Modification for the reasons given in our original response

We believe Ofgems further consultation raises a different issue with what the intention of original modification 0353 is trying to resolve.

The issue of the "The Gas Supply Licence definition in SLC6 is not exactly mirrored under UNC353. In particular, the UNC353 definition is based on "use" at the premises whereas the gas supply licence definition is influenced by the contractual arrangements".

We acknowledge that the licence and the code should be consistent in terms of definition. However, in this instance we feel that this should be raised as a separate modification altogether. The intent of the original modification is to populate the Market sector code within the supply point register rather than the clarification of the definition of terms.
