Grain LNG phase 4: revocation of third party access exemption. We previously granted National Grid Grain LNG (GLNG), as owner of an LNG import and export facility, an exemption from the application of section 19D of the Gas Act 1986 in respect of phase 4 of the development of the Isle of Grain LNG terminal and this was approved by the European Commission on 4 June 2013. The Gas Act and European law require exemptions to be revoked if construction not started within 2 years of approval.
