Action DX 1202: Modification 0551 –

Xoserve to provide supporting information (scale of ratchet charges, and number of sites to which these might be applied over the relevant period) to accompany the Variation Request



Validations

- Candidate MPRNs as defined by Modification 0551¹ are:
 - Any Daily Metered Supply Meter Points (DM SMP) which comprised part of an aggregated configuration as at 01/10/14* date
 - and which were subsequently disaggregated under UNC Mod 0428 requirements
 - and which remained as DM
- Modification 0551 proposes that candidate MPRNs are subject to two tests, both measured using the combined UDQO of the disaggregated DM SMPs:
 - Test 1 Against the combined registered SOQ of the newly disaggregated DM SMPs, and
 - Test 2 Against the previously registered aggregated SOQ
- If the combined UDQO is lower than the greater of the two figures, relief from the ratchet incentive charge will be provided.

During the period October 15 – November 15, there are 8 MPRNs which are considered eligible candidates, of which all would qualify for relief from the ratchet incentive charge.

The combined ratchet relief value is approximately £60, 000 across the eligible MPRNs.
