## UNC Modification 0550 – Incentivising Central Project Delivery.

•This Modification proposes an implementation backstop date for Project Nexus.

•Proposes incentive payments from Gas Transporters to Gas Shippers should the delivery of central system solution be delayed further

•Is not a Self Governance Modification as it introduces financial liabilities.

•The modification is inclusive of Modification 0432 and 0434 (Project Nexus Gas Demand Estimation, Allocation, Settlement and Reconcilliation Reform and Project Nexus Retrospective Adjustment.)

•The backstop date will be the current agreed Go-live date of Project Nexus as at the Implementation date of the modification.

•The incentive will take the form of a payment from Gas Transporters to Gas Shippers who have met both the initial and the revised implementation dates.



•The financial incentive should act to reduce the risk of cost over-runs to consumers and therefore improve competition.

•Further delay will result in extra costs for Gas Shippers and Suppliers to test, design and implement the solution.

•Further delay will also increase costs by extending the length of Shipper's delivery programmes.

•By defining a firm date for delivery it assists the parties in planning during a period of considerable industry change.
