- Options for addressing the decline in the datalogger based sample serving large NDM modelling
- Presenting sample size as a percentage of the population it represents.
- The effects of downward revision of AQ on the bands that sample points fall into
- The effectiveness of the Market Sector Flag and implications for analysis
- Strategy for potential split of 732-2196 MWh band, if the spring 2006 data and analysis indicates a potential need for this.
