5.5.11	Supply Point Objections	Where any of the circumstances in TPD Section G2.5.8(b)(i), (ii) or (iii) apply, i.e. 'non-competitive transfers':
		- the minimum 4 Supply Point Systems Business Days does not apply, so as to be consistent with the approach in paragraph 5.5.10;
		- subject to the rules on Non-TPD Communication and Non-elapsed Time Days, a User can submit a Supply Point Objection after the 'cut off date', subject to the normal 4 Supply Point Systems Business Days rule.
5.5.12	Supply Point Objections	Where a Supply Point Confirmation is submitted on 20 or 21 May 2017 with a Proposed Supply Point Registration Date of 8 June 2017 the CDSP will notify the incumbent User by 13:00 on 22 May 2017 and the User will have a short objection window, i.e. up until 23:00 on the same day.
