Market Trials L2 Update

- P1 incident on 2nd November involving the interface between EFT and AMT resulting in all outbound files being halted and all market participants requested to refrain from sending inbound files until further notice
- Incident Management team immediately put in place
- System back up and running and remedial activity on Wednesday 4th November PM
- Full root cause analysis in progress
- Progress reported to the industry on a daily basis

Defect position

- 11 defects were raised in pipe cleaning but not included in these figures – 3 have been closed
- Due to serious issues with access to HPQC this week, some defects in HPQC have not yet been updated, therefore, it is expected that the number outstanding will drop in the early part of next week.
- 11 defects are associated with multiple organisations
