In October 2006 Ofgem established two industry workstreams to consider the extent to which gas quality could restrict future gas imports to Great Britain, and the appropriate commercial and regulatory arrangements to underpin a potential treatment facility built to address this problem. Conclusions to these workstreams were published by Ofgem in January.

The Economic Regulation workstream identified a regulatory framework based on regulated and unregulated principles as the most appropriate for any treatment facility. To support this approach, National Grid Gas (or others) would need to raise modifications to the Uniform Network Code. To facilitate this we are holding a one day Transmission Workstream workshop on Gas Quality.

Many of the elements constituting the potential gas quality service need to be developed in conjunction with industry parties. Therefore we would encourage as much industry participation as possible.
