1. Introduction

BF welcome all to the meeting.

2. Outline of Modification

ARa introduced the modification. He explained that the purpose of the modification is to allow additional read types to be used for reconciliations, aligning the iGT arrangements with those in the UNC.

KK asked if this would address historic, outstanding reconciliations. ARa confirmed this was expected.

AW asked if any changes are needed to the iGT UNC, and ARa confirmed that none were anticipated. The change will be enacted via modification of Annex A of the LDZ CSEP NExA, and the process for modifying that is to raise a UNC modification.

KK was concerned that the improvement may not be material because of the reliance on AQs and there was no guarantee that the accuracy of AQs would be improved. However, she believed that increased use of actual reads, including opening reads, would be beneficial.
