JM provided an overview of the legal text, pointing out that the text does not advocate a wholesale review of SOQs, only where the Transporter believes there is a material network issue involved. GE was concerned that the text as drafted may inadvertently place an absolute obligation on shippers that requires them to obtain information from customers - this could, for example, oblige them to take customers to court in order to obtain the relevant information. It was agreed that it would seem appropriate for this to be reworded as a reasonable endeavours obligation. JM undertook to review the legal text in light of the discussions.

It was agreed that the Workgroup Report should be submitted to the Panel, with a recommendation that it proceed to consultation.
