1.0 Review of Minutes and Actions

1.1. Minutes

The minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

2.0 Discussion

The modification had been amended following discussions at the last meeting.

There was a brief discussion on the different interpretations of a '3 week' switching period. AJe pointed out that the systems work over 22 days, but DECC refers to 21 calendar days, so 'doing nothing' was not an option – should this be reflected in the Report as Shippers cannot comply with the Third Package requirement as currently drafted in the Licence. LW clarified that the current process does not allow Shippers to transfer in 21 days if the day of submission was included in the day count. However, if a Shipper confirmed within the 'cooling off' period then it would be compliant.

DL confirmed no further amendments to the modification were envisaged.

Review of Legal Text

There were no comments in respect of the legal text, and DL confirmed no further amendments were envisaged. The Workgroup agreed that the changes should be reflected in its Report.

Completion of Workgroup Report

BF advised that the reporting date for the Workgroup Report had been extended to January 2012, to align with new Modification 0403. The benefits of such alignment were considered, and the Workgroup concluded that there was no reason to delay submission of its Report to the Panel if it was finalised at an earlier date.

The Workgroup Report was reviewed. The relevant objectives, advantages and disadvantages were considered and the Workgroup agreed to recommend that this modification should proceed to consultation.

The Workgroup Report will be finalised and submitted to the Panel on 17 November 2011.
