## 1.0 Introduction and Status Review

BF reminded the Workgroup of the requests made by Panel.

The Workgroup had been requested to:

- Consider the points raised by Ofgem;
- Clarify the solution and supporting business rules;
- Identify an implementation path, covering the nature of the systems changes and if the modification is subject to User Pays; and
- Present a further report to the October Panel.

## 2.0 Final Modification Report

CW confirmed all the points raised by Ofgem had been addressed and the Legal Text had been amended with some minor changes to the business rules. JD had no further questions to raise and confirmed that none of the questions previously raised had been left outstanding.

BF highlighted that the Joint Office were expecting a variation request from the proposer to amend the business rules.

The Workgroup considered the Final Modification Report and captured that all elements had been considered however the Workgroup had not had visibility of the variation request.

TD asked if there were going to be any system changes or user pays costs associated with the modification. CWa did not think there would be any user pays costs as the same functionality required for Modification 0424 could be utilised. HCh was aware that some of the functionality required would be provided through the implementation of Modification 0424. However, there may be other system impacts, which may incur systems costs.

HCh agreed to provide an update on any additional costs at the next meeting to allow completion of the report.

The Workgroup agreed the Final Modification Report could be finalised 26 September 2013 for submission to the October UNC Modification Panel for consideration.
