1.0 Review of Minutes and Actions

1.1 Minutes

2.0 Completion of the Workgroup Report

The draft workgroup report was reviewed, focusing on the relevant objectives, the implementation costs and implementation date.

<u>Relevant Objectives.</u> CW remained concerned that the issues raised by Ofgem when rejecting Modification 0119 had not been addressed, notably regarding a lack of cost reflectivity. NR agreed that further justification would prove beneficial in demonstrating why this modification is different to 0119.

MW confirmed that National Grid NTS believe they have provided a full justification for the modification, with the basis of the proposed overrun charge

being consistent with the views set out by Ofgem in their decision for Modification 0341 "Manifest Errors in Entry Capacity Overrun".

<u>Impacts and Costs</u> – GJ questioned the principle behind the proposed application of User Pays charges to Shippers. Not charging parties that overrun is counter intuitive to the principle behind User Pays – it implies charging only those that do not use the service. MW noted that parties had requested a simple approach, and this had been put forward. While recognising this may be appropriate for low cost changes, GJ emphasised that this should not be regarded as a precedent.

<u>Implementation</u> – it was noted that it was not envisaged that the modification would be implemented (subject to Ofgem approval) before any system changes were ready. The Workgroup agreed the section of the Workgroup Report regarding implementation, which reflected discussions on the low materiality of the modification relative to the implementation cost. NR added that Ofgem would welcome Shipper views as part of the consultation process.

TD advised that the Workgroup Report would now be submitted for the consideration at the meeting of the August Modification Panel.
